



## Men's Italian American Civic League Scholarship

**To:** Utah High School Seniors of recent Italian Ancestry  
**From:** Men's Italian American Civic League  
**Deadline:** March 15, 2020

**About** Founded in 1934, the Italian American Civic League (IACL) is a non-profit organization for Italian-Americans in the State of Utah that promotes civil, social, and educational growth. This scholarship is for Utah high school seniors who strive to promote these principles.

**Eligibility** Both females and males are invited to apply for this scholarship. Applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- 1) Application Form (see page 2)
- 2) Be a 2020 graduate of any high school in State of Utah
- 3) Be planning to matriculate as a degree seeking student at any public or private higher education institution.

**Applying** Submit the following material by the application deadline of March 15, 2020

- 1) Application form (see page 2)
- 2) A resume emphasizing academic and extracurricular activities
- 3) Essay 1: What are your future education/career and goals? (300 words max)
- 4) Essay 2: Describe your Italian ancestry. How has your Italian ancestry influenced your life? (600 words max)
- 5) Essay 3: Why are you the best candidate to receive the Men's Italian American Civic League Scholarship? (300 words max)
- 6) Official High School Transcript with ACT and/or SAT scores.

**Selection** Application will be assessed and ranked based on the following:

- 1) Extracurricular Activity involvement (25%)
- 2) Essays (25%)
- 3) High School Academic Performance (25%)
- 4) ACT or SAT exam scores (5%)
- 5) Involvement with Italian Cultural Organizations (20%)

**Award** The scholarship award will be paid directly to the recipient for their use towards tuition, books, housing, and or fees. Awards range from \$1000 to \$4,000  
With scholarship acceptance, the recipient agrees to submit a recent digital photograph and short biography. These items will be published in the program book for FESTA ITALIANA (the Salt Lake City Italian Festival) and IACL publications.  
Scholarships are awarded by both the Men's and Women's Chapters of the IACL. Applicants are encouraged to apply for both scholarships, but cannot receive both awards per IACL bylaws.
