The Women's Italian American Civic League is awarding two (2)

\$1,000 Scholarships

Deadline: March 15, 2020

Eligibility

An applicant must be of Italian ancestry and a 2020 graduate of a Utah high school.

Criteria

The scholarship is awarded based on American College Test (ACT) or Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) entrance exams (40%), exceptional high school ability (40%), extracurricular (school, church, community service, etc.) activities (20%). To be considered for this scholarship, the applicant must be admitted as a matriculated degree student by the applicant's chosen institute of higher education.

Requirements

- 1. Complete application form (see attached for details).**
- 2. Official transcript with copy of ACT or SAT scores.**
- 3. Outline of extracurricular activities**
- 4. Summary of future educational goals and why you are the best candidate for this scholarship.**
- 5. A personal essay (max 300 words) describing:
The applicant's Italian ancestry and how it has influenced your life**

OTHER CONDITIONS

With scholarship acceptance, the recipient agrees to submit a recent digital photograph and short biography. Scholarships are awarded by both the Men's and Women's Chapters of the IACL.

Both men and women applicants are encouraged to apply for both scholarships, but cannot receive both awards per IACL bylaws. The scholarship Committee selects the recipient. The scholarship will be paid directly to the successful candidate.

Include the name(s) of your Italian ancestor(s) and approximately when they immigrated to the US. Include information about which part of Italy they immigrated from and their relationship to you.
5. Why you are the best candidate to receive the Women's Italian-American Civic League scholarship.
6. Optional: a list of family members or friends who are active in the Italian American Civic League Men's or Women's Chapters.

Application material must be postmarked no later than **March 15, 2020**.
