The Women's Italian American Civic League is awarding

two (2) \$1000 Scholarships

Deadline: February 13, 2019

Eligibility

An applicant must be of Italian ancestry and a 2019 graduate of a Utah school.

Criteria

The scholarship is awarded based on American College Test (ACT) or Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) college entrance exams (40%), exceptional high school ability (40%), extracurricular (school, church, community service) activities (20%). To be considered for this scholarship, the applicant must be admitted as a matriculated degree student by the applicant's chosen institute of higher education.

Requirements

1. Complete application form (see attached for details).
2. Official transcript with a copy of ACT or SAT scores.
3. Outline of extracurricular activities.
4. Summary of future educational goals and why you are the best candidate for this scholarship.
5. A personal essay (maximum 300 words) describing:
 - a. The applicant's Italian ancestry
 - b. How this ancestry has influenced your life.

Your essay is a critical part of the application. Tell us your story.

Other Conditions

Upon scholarship acceptance, the recipient is required to submit a recent photograph and short biography. The Men's and Women's Chapters of the Italian-American Civic League offer scholarships for both men and women. You are encouraged to apply for each chapter's scholarship. However, one recipient MAY NOT receive both scholarships. The Scholarship Awards Committee selects the recipient. The scholarship will be paid directly to the successful candidate.

3. Summary of education goals

 - a. Include the name(s) of your Italian ancestor(s) and approximately when they immigrated to the U.S. Include information about which part of Italy they immigrated from and their relationship to you.
5. Why you are the best candidate to receive the Women's Italian-American Civic League scholarship.
6. Optional: a list of family members or friends who are active in the Italian-American Civic League
